# Project Area Overview & Operations

# Santos



- Facilities, pipelines & licenses straddle Southern Highlands, Hela, Gulf, NCD & Central provinces.
- 1 million+ ha of land = production, pipeline licenses, retention & exploration licenses
- 65,000+ legitimate PNG LNG Project beneficiaries', approx. 35,000+ from STO brownfields
- 8 Local-Level Government areas
- 13 language groups
- 400+ Incorporated Land Groups (ILGS) – legal mechanism for benefit distribution
- Kumul Marine Terminal (critical export infrastructure)
- 6 producing oil fields / 1 producing gas field

## Economic Pathways -



**Education infrastructure & Partnerships.** Strengthened relationship between Provincial Education Advisory services and Schools in the PIA and a sustainable plan for school inspections.

**Support small business development.** Small businesses with strong governance and business continuity plans have been established across the PIAs.

Improved communication and collaboration between provincial law & justice institutions and PIA communities

### Water, Sanitation & Hygiene.

Increased access to clean and safe water and sanitation for PIA communities. Proportion of population using safely managed drinking water and sanitation services.


