

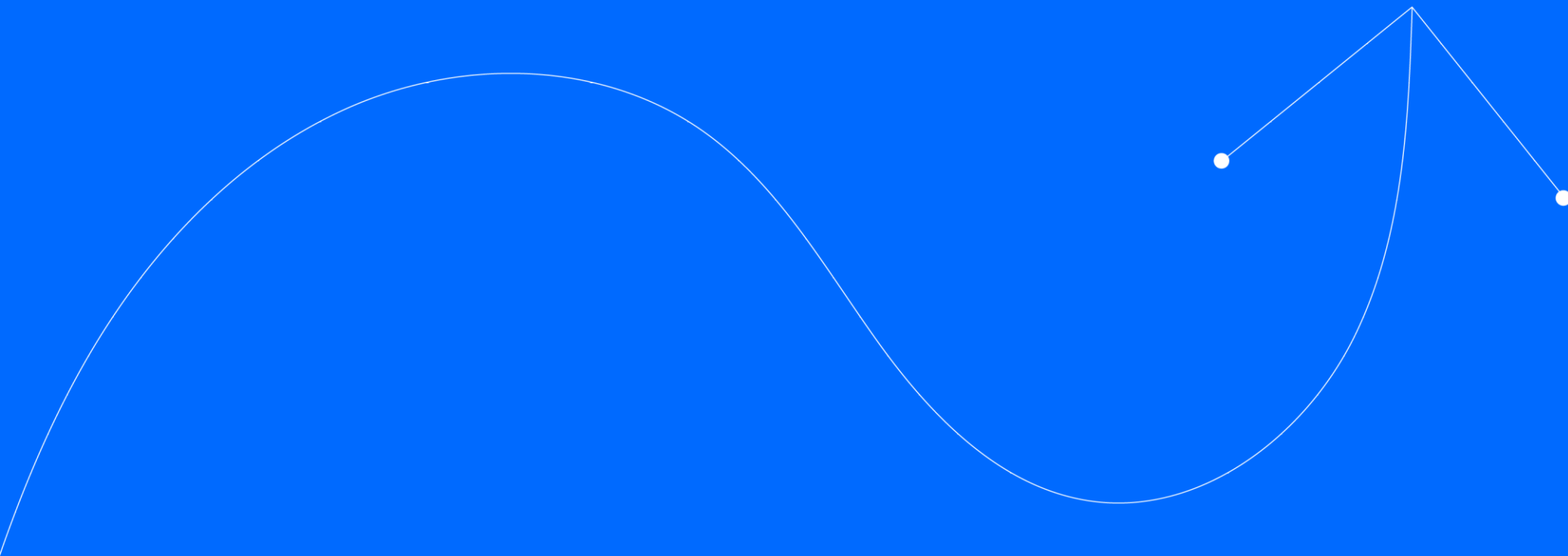

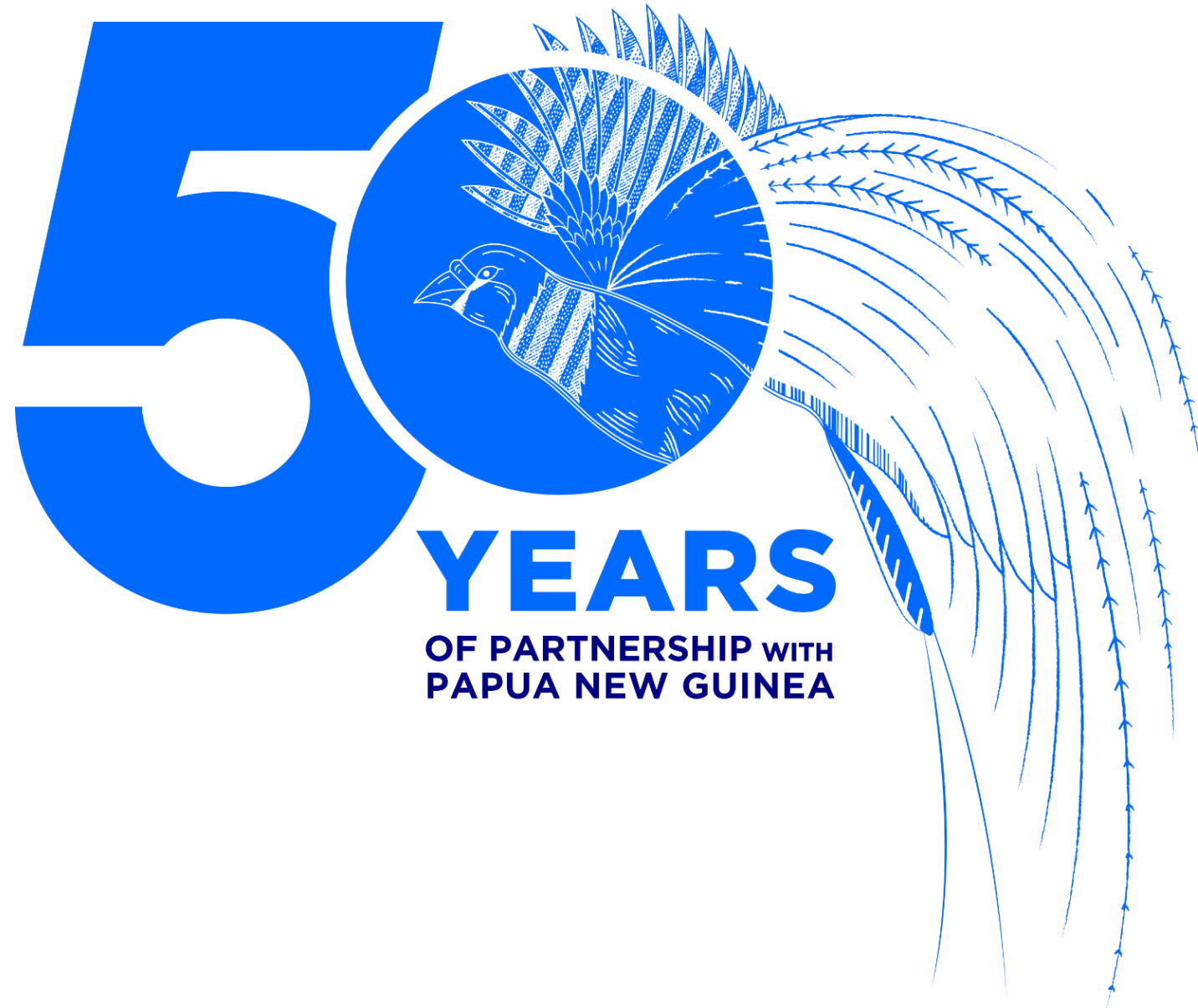

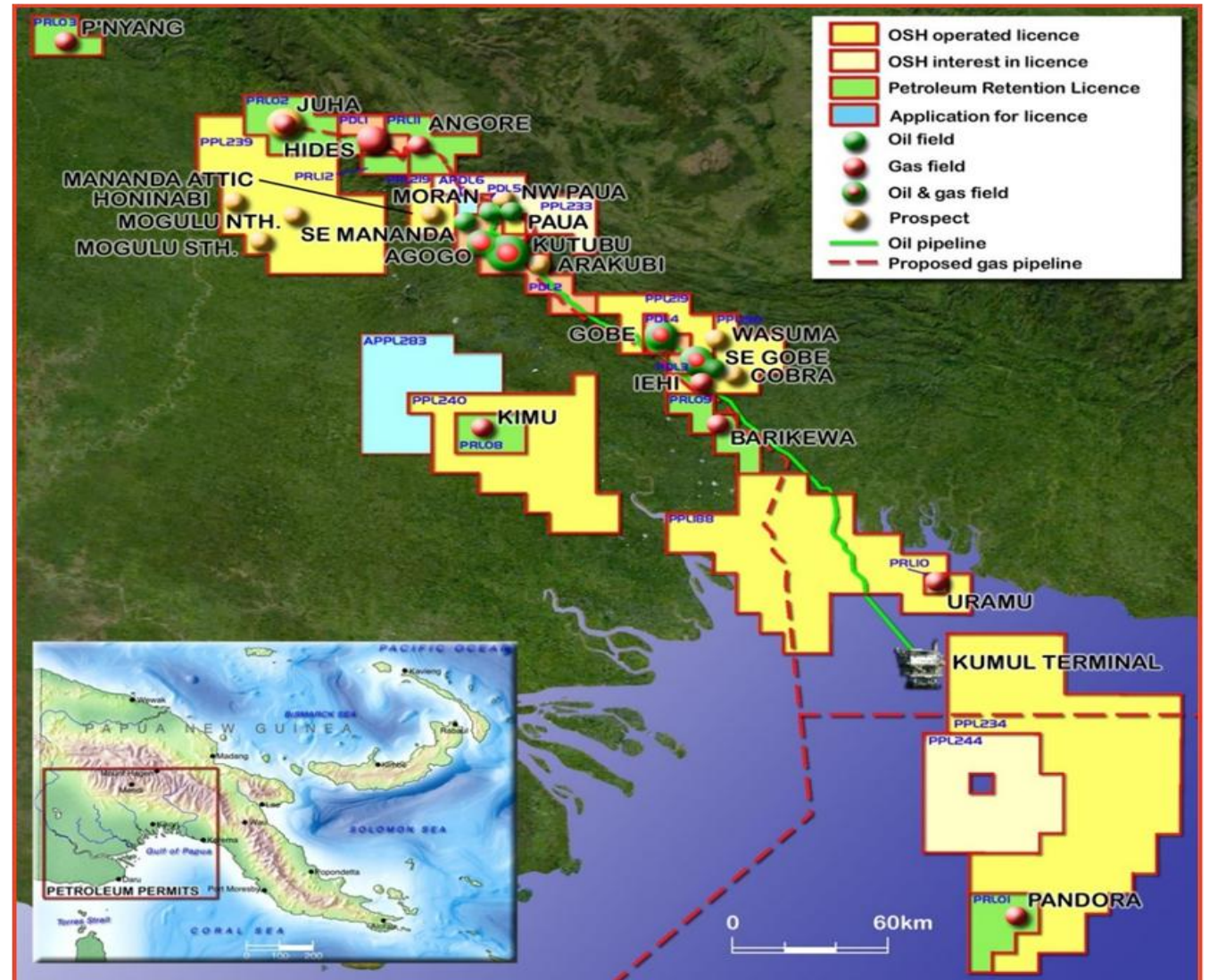




Education Sponsorship Program Area Coverage

Key Outcome / Purpose

- Building relationships with project area communities and upcoming leaders.
- Promote Sustainable Human Resource Development in Technical, Health, Education, Agriculture, Business and Theological Studies as part of Corporate Social Responsibility.
- Provide support to eligible locals who may be disadvantaged by poverty, lack of roads, schools or other infrastructure that are facing difficulty in getting into higher institutions.

Program History

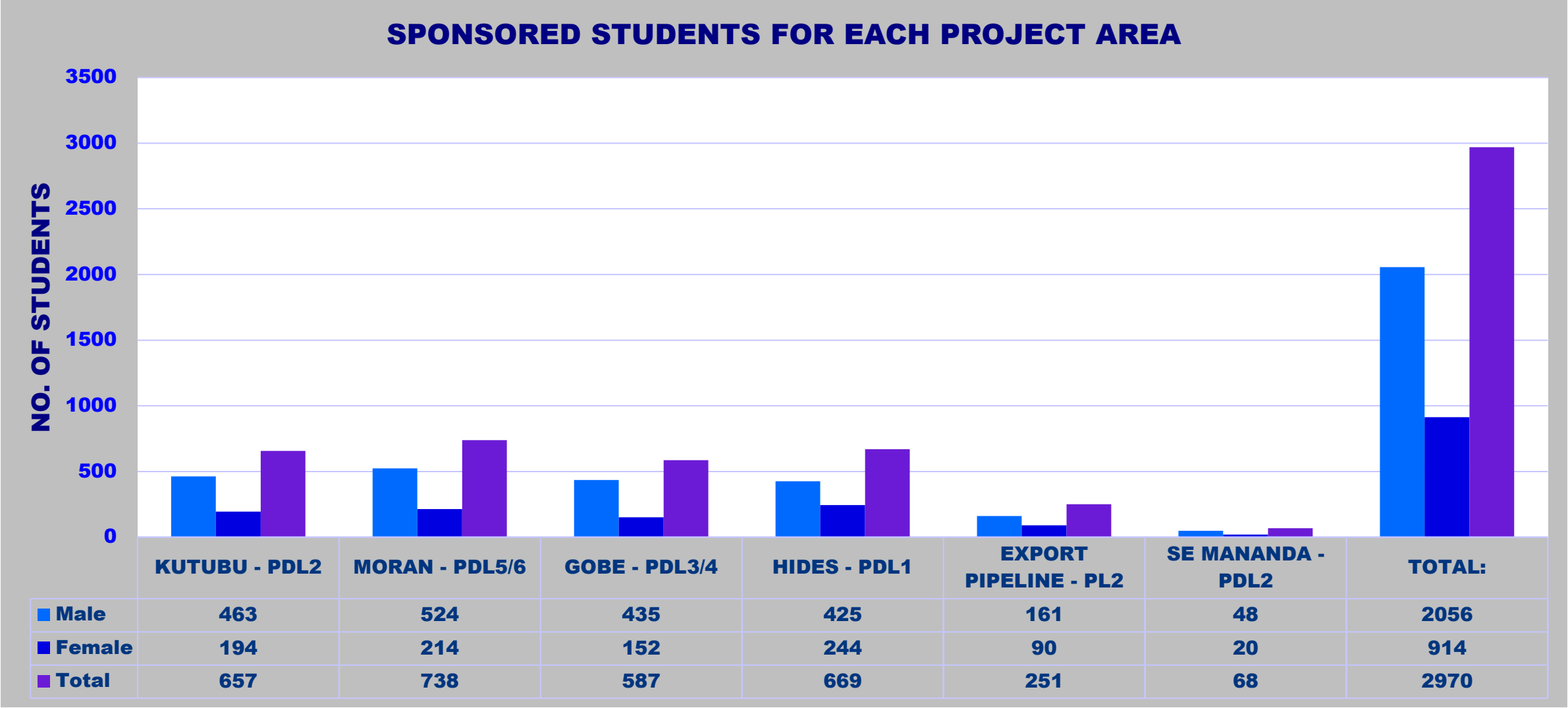
- Education Sponsorship Program commenced in 1996.
- This sponsorship support is only for local project area community and weighting given to female students to address gender imbalance.
- Sponsorship covers the costs of tuition, on-campus lodging, book allowances, airfares and pocket allowance.
- The sponsorship program is for a 3 - year period and includes the second, third and the final academic year.



Total number of students sponsored

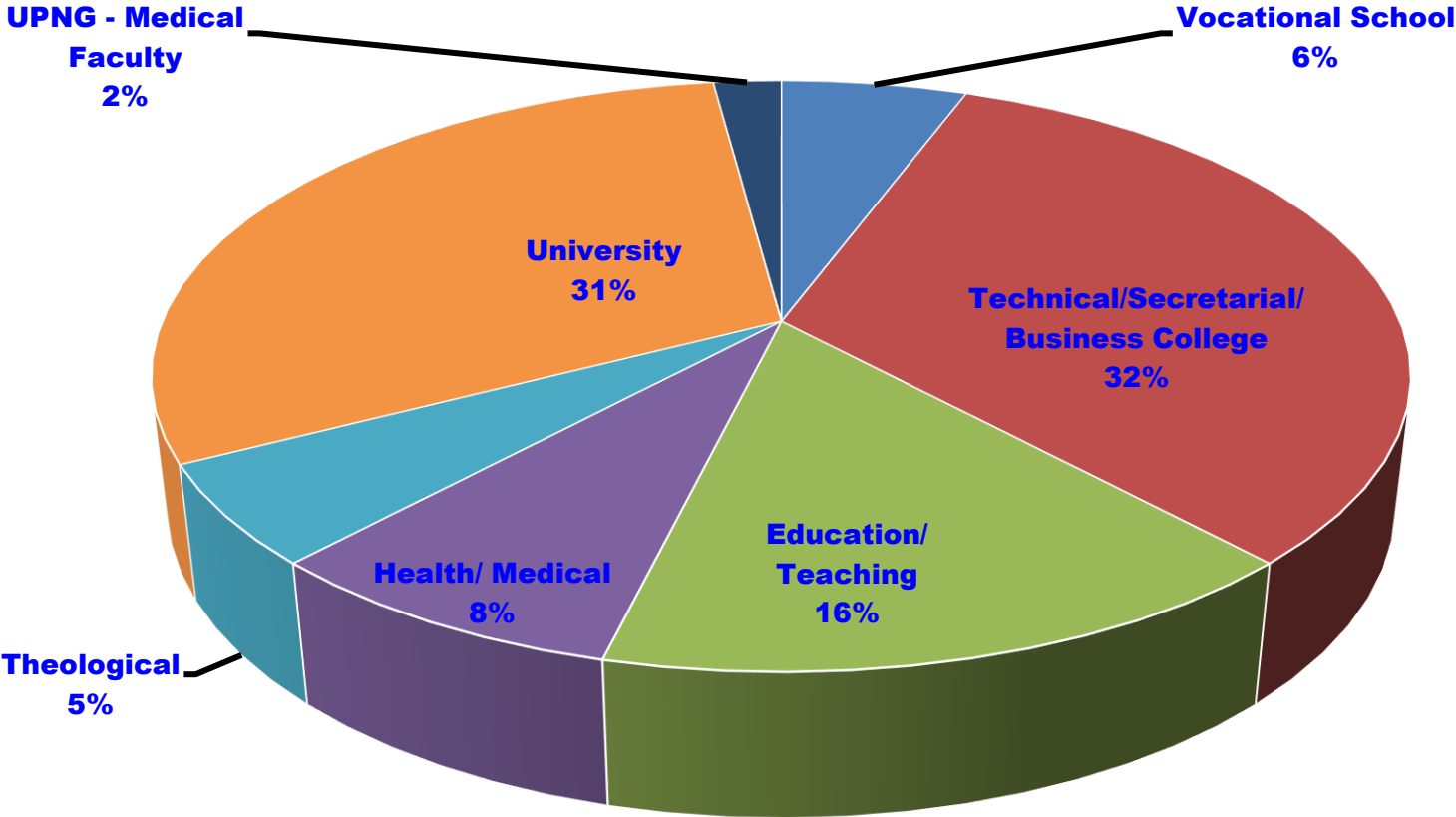

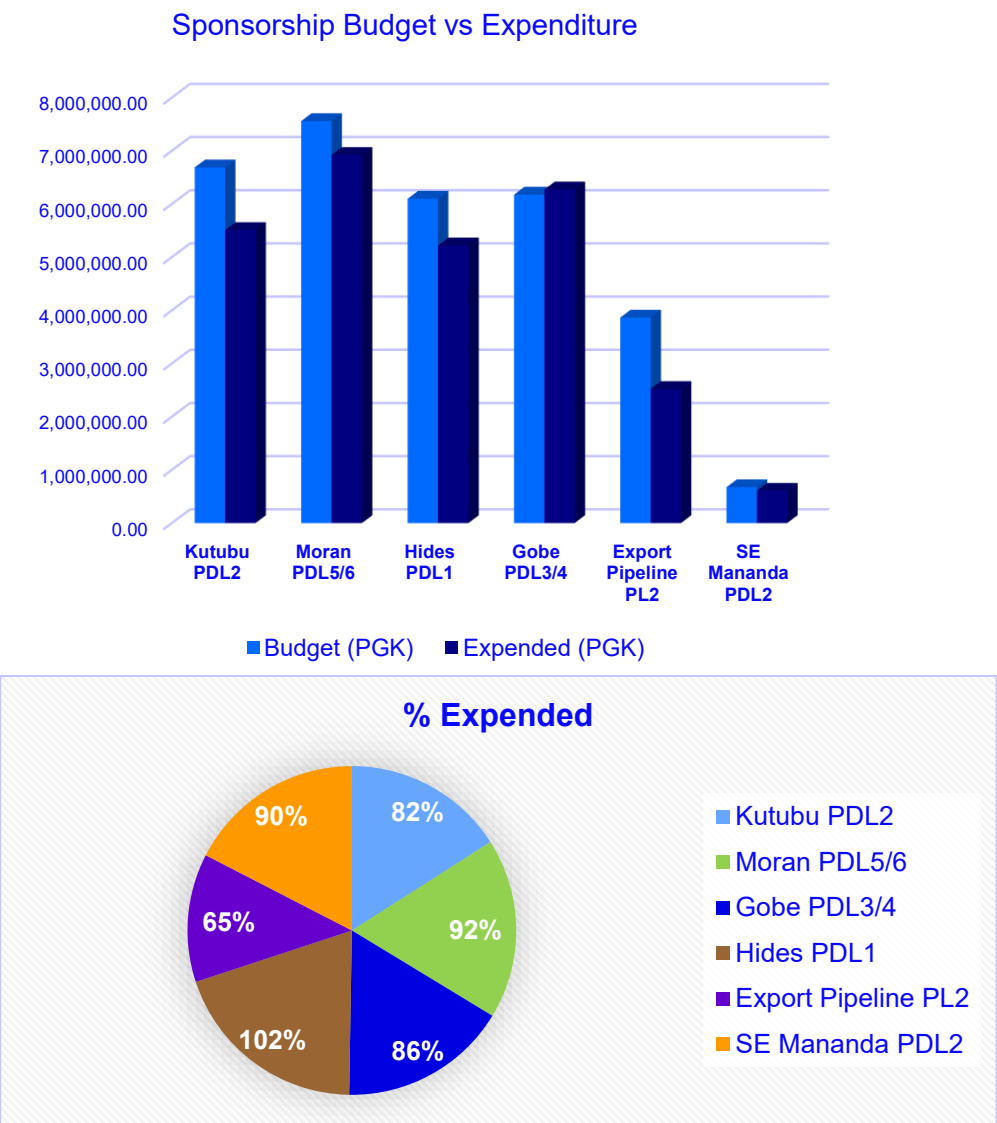
