

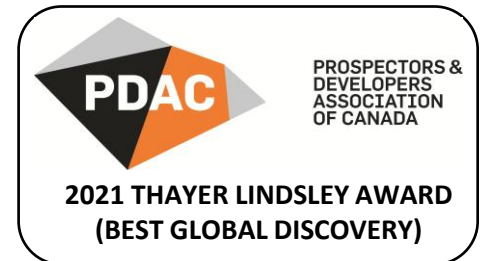

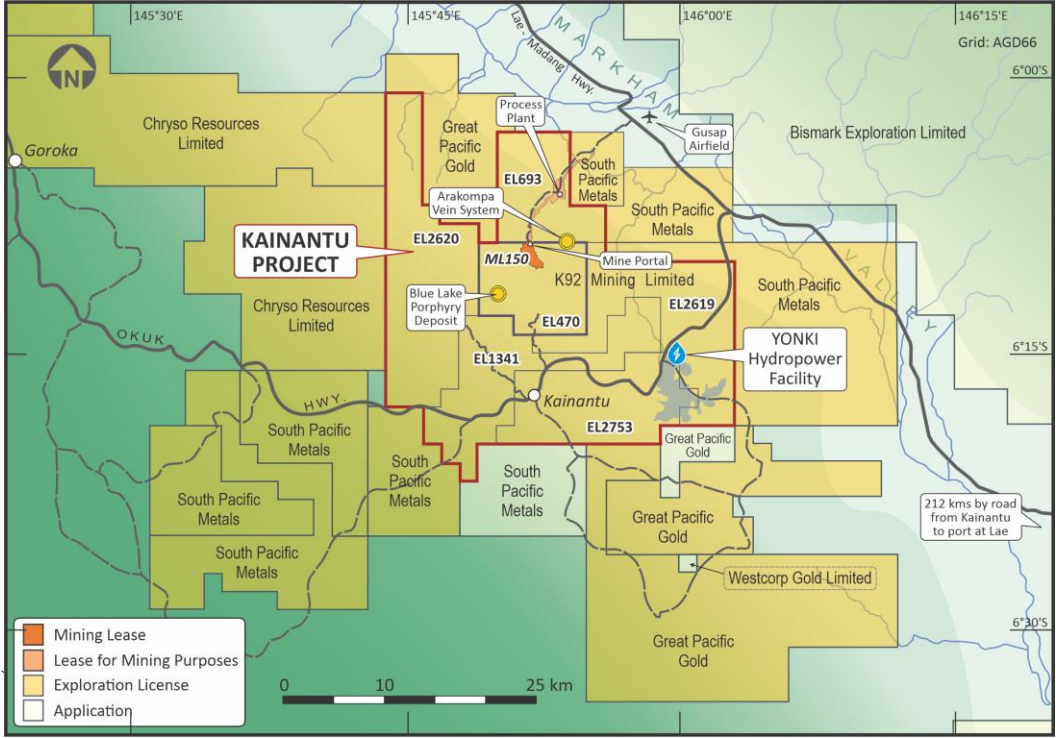

- Land area used: 66.5 hectares - Small holder farming



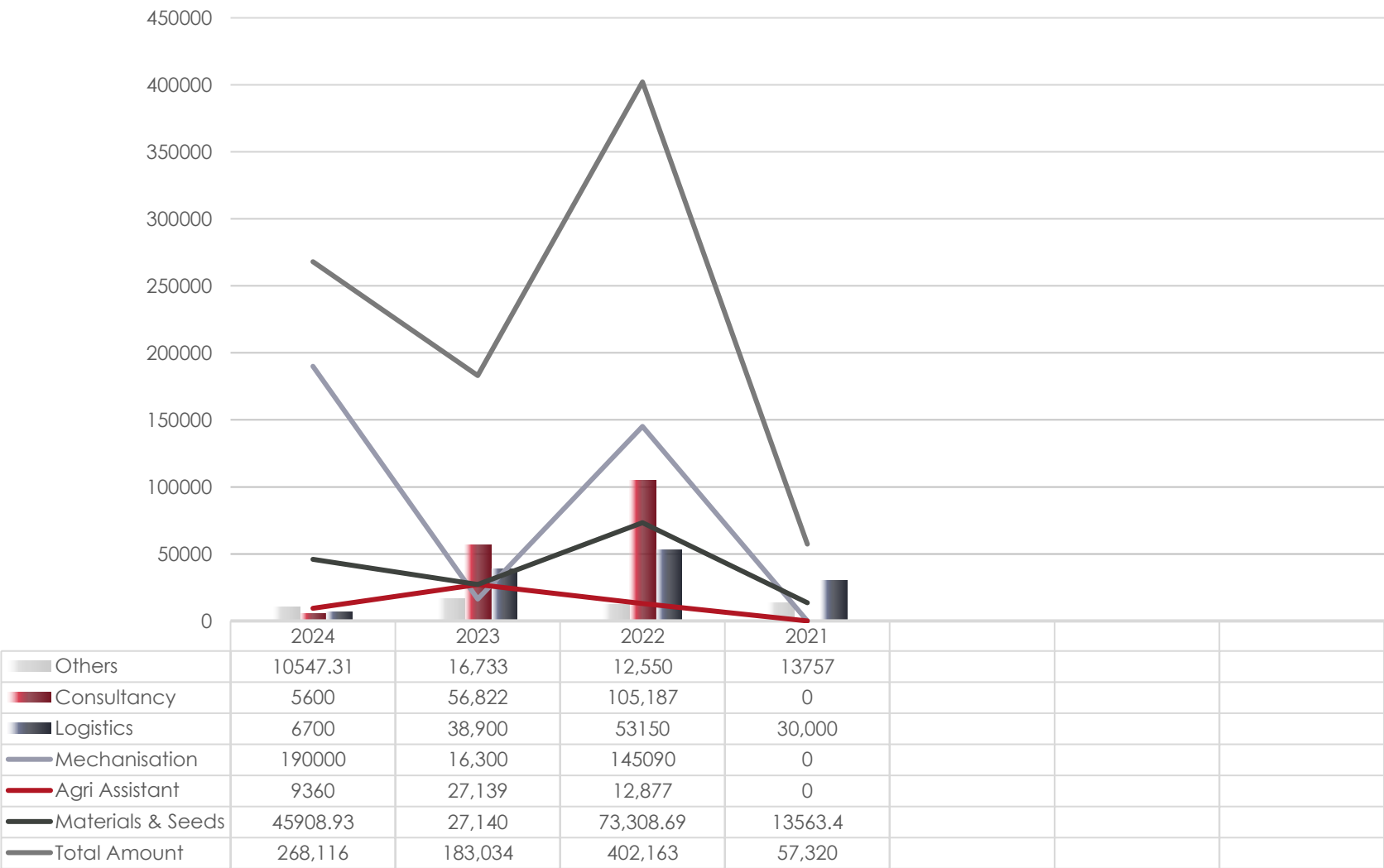

CHALLENGES

- Parts of road access to Highlands communities deteriorated.
- Shifting farmers mindset from subsistence farming to commercial farming.
- Community politics.

MITIGATIONS

- Road maintenance through Tax Credit scheme is underway.
- Working on securing market agreements
- Leadership Trainings for model farm leaders
- K92's Sweat Equity Strategy

COMPLIMENTING FRESH PRODUCE – COCOA & COFFEE

- We cannot eat cocoa and coffee, but we will eat vegetables
- Fresh Produce must form the basis of K92's agricultural programs.
- Venturing now into Cocoa and Coffee Rehabilitation – Collaboration with SPISARD/Cocoa Board.
